Peter Pretorius is the Founder and Group Chief Executive Officer of South African-founded international NGO, Joint Aid Management (JAM) International. Last year JAM celebrated 30 years of Helping Africa Help Itself. Peter was motivated to establish JAM in 1984 after he witnessed extreme hunger, poverty and death at a food distribution camp in Pambarra, Mozambique where he was stuck for 10 days. Peter and his wife Ann have dedicated their entire lives to empowering impoverished communities in Africa.

JAM as an international humanitarian and development organization is feeding more than 1 million beneficiaries daily through their nutritional school-feeding projects. In the last 32 years, more than 1.2 billion meals have been served to its beneficiaries in Africa. JAM has affiliate offices in Germany, Switzerland, America, Canada, UK and Africa, and implements projects at grass-roots level in Mozambique, South Africa, South Sudan, Rwanda and Angola, providing food security, micronutrient intervention, assistance to orphans and vulnerable children, the drilling of water wells, delivery of sanitation and health training, skills development, and community-based agricultural development.

Testament to the high level of commitment and dedication over the past three decades, Peter and his wife were one of five global nominees in the AidEx 2014 Humanitarian Hero of the Year Award.
